The following addendum supersedes information contained in the solicitation document issued for this procurement to the extent referenced. This Addendum forms part of the solicitation documents and will be subject to all the conditions set out in the contract conditions.

RFQ No. 2025-014Q-MPQ TAG Recycling Collection

1. Is there any trucking permit required, if it is a requirement which kind of permit?

Not from a waste collection perspective. However, the contractor will ensure that all vehicles and equipment used within the contract are approved, registered and licensed by the Transport Control Department and comply with any national regulations or legislation.

2. How many pick up days are there in a calendar year?(56)

Over a 52-week period there will be 52 days of scheduled household collections required under contract using the current collection methodology (fortnightly collections done on Thursday and Friday). However, it should be noted that the contract also includes TAG recycling collections from domestic flats/condos, public docks, schools, Government Institutions including WEDCO and BLDC (excluding those in Corporation of Hamilton), Tynes Bay public drop off and bus stops which will potentially increase the number of collection days required per year.

3. Are we bidding on the whole two-year contract or one year at a time.

Contractors are bidding for an initial 2-year contract with the potential for a 2-year extension to be agreed by both parties (2+2 years).

4. Where will the collections be dropped off?

All collected TAG recycling material will be taken to the Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) based at the Government's Quarry site.

5. What are the access times at the drop off location or locations and will we have access to the location after 4:30 pm?

All TAG recyclable materials must be delivered to the MRF between 7:30am and 3:30pm. Temporary evening extensions past 3:30pm may be granted only if the Contractor makes the request to the Government before 2pm on any given day.

6. After collecting recyclables are they weighed and where?

All collected TAG material must be weighed at a government weighbridge (Quarry, Tynes Bay) before it is dropped off at the MRF. The contractor will keep accurate records of each load weighed and will keep the weigh bill as evidence for billing purposes.

7. From what time in the morning can we start our pick-ups ?

From 7:30am.

8. Are all the pick-ups at the same location as the trash truck pickups?

Generally, yes but this is not 100% accurate. The contractor would be expected to ensure that, where different, all TAG material collection points are learnt, managed and collected from.
